Competition Requirements

This show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the United States Rules for Working Equitation, Revision 6 dated January 1, 2023. The rules can be found at the following site: <https://usawe.org/rules>. **It is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules prior to the competition.**

All competitors holding a membership with USAWE may compete. Non-members are allowed to compete in rated shows for a \$20 non-member fee. Non-members can use a one-time voucher in place of the non-member fee.

Competitors interested in being eligible for lifetime medal awards and year-end awards must be USAWE members.

All competing horses must be recorded with USAWE in advance of the show. A one-time fee of \$20 per horse includes lifetime performance tracking.

Riders with disabilities can apply for a Dispensation Certificate that approves the use of adaptive equipment and other allowances.

A single horse and rider team is allowed to show in only one level. A horse may be entered twice in a competition if ridden by two different riders and in different levels. Exception: Two youth can share the same horse if competing in Level 1. See Rulebook, Section 1.7.

*****Riders must designate the level and division in which they want to compete on the entry form:**

- Youth riders may show in Youth, Amateur, or Open.
- Amateur riders may show in Amateur or Open.
- Open riders must show in the Open division.

*****Leaderboard points will be reported according to the level/division shown.**

Riders must be correctly attired, and horses properly presented in accordance with the U.S. Rules for Working Equitation. Show Management may, at its discretion, bar any person or horse from entering the arena if not suitably presented.

Team Competitors

All competitors will compete for individual scores. Competitors that want to compete in teams will be eligible for additional awards and prizes. Teams of 3-4 horse and rider pairs will be designated on the entry form. Introductory Level riders may only compete with other Introductory Level teammates. Novice through Master Level riders may all compete together on a team.

For each trial, individual team member scores are compared with one another to determine the placing for that trial. Points for each team member are computed as described in section 4.8.2. of the USAWE rulebook. The number of points available is based on the total number of riders on all competing teams, e.g., 4 teams with 4 riders each would be a total of 16 points, where the highest score would get 17 points, the second highest 15 points, etc. The point basis determined for the Dressage trial will remain the same for all subsequent trials. A team's total point score is computed by adding the points for the team's top three riders in each of the trials. The teams are ranked according to the total team points.

Cattle Trial

The Cattle Trial is optional and open to L2-L7 competitors. Experienced turnback riders will assist individual competitors.

Full Refunds less the office fee will be issued for cancelations prior to closing date. After closing date, refunds will be granted with a note from physician or veterinarian and at the sole discretion of Three Bulls and show management.

Checks returned for non-sufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 fee by Three Bulls for each occurrence.

No entry may show unless all entry fees are paid in full.

Late entries must pay electronically.

Entry Procedures

- A separate entry form must be completed for each horse-rider combination.
- The entry form is included as an attachment to this Prize List and can also be found on Three Bulls website: www.threebullsfarm.com
- An entry form is not valid unless it is fully completed and has all the **proper signatures, membership numbers, and horse information.**

- Each entry form must have the original (not copies) signatures of Riders/Handlers and Owner/Agent.
- An adult must sign for any junior rider.
- Mail or email **entry forms and fees** to the **Show Secretary**.
- Entries must be received by the closing date; entries received after the closing date will be assessed a **\$50** late fee and possibly be placed on a waiting list.
- No phone entries will be accepted. Entries are accepted on a first-paid, first-served basis.
- USAWE uses the same qualifications for **Amateur Riders** as the USEF (GR 1306). So please know these rules.
- Photocopy of negative **Coggins** test, dated within one year of the end of the show, must accompany the entry form. Entries without a current (valid through show date) **Coggins** test result will not be accepted.

Any **non-competing horses** must have an entry form sent in with a current negative **Coggins** test.

Prizes/Awards

- Rosettes awarded from 1st thru 5th place in each class for Open, Amateur, and Youth divisions. (Master's classes are Open only).
- Championship and Reserve Championship rosettes will be awarded to the overall first and second place rider/horse teams in each level/division.
- PRIZE MONEY: Open, Amateur, and Youth divisions will be combined and the top three scores (from the average Dressage and EOH scores) in every level will earn 50% of the prize monies for 1st, 30% for 2nd and 20% for 3rd. Total amount TBD.
- Cattle Trial winner will be awarded prize money and a trophy.

Stabling Details

- Three Bulls LLC has 12 x 12 box stalls, all with individual fans installed. There are a limited number of small pens with shelters that will be offered on a first come, first served basis.
- Tennessee law requires a current **health certificate** for horses arriving from out of state. Your horse cannot be stabled on the grounds without a health certificate.
- Competitors may show out of their trailer. There will be a **\$50 charge for the weekend**.

Arrival: Thursday, May 18, after 12:00 p.m. Departure: Monday, May 23, by 11:00 a.m.

Competitors are welcome to arrive early and/or depart later. Early arrivals/late departures must be coordinated with and approved by the **Stable Manager, Arielle Funaro** and will be subject to an additional **\$50 charge per stall/pen per day**.

- Emergency contact information must be prominently displayed on all stalls housing an animal, including both cell phone and local contact information.
- **Please do not use stalls you have not paid for.**

Tack Stalls

- A limited amount of tack stalls will be available on a first come, first served basis for \$100 for the weekend.
- We encourage competitors to share tack stalls.

General Information

- Three Bulls reserves the right to refuse an entry for any reason.
- **Three Bulls LLC and Three Bulls Classic Shows** reserve the right to maintain a **Harassment Free Environment** and may remove or refuse entry to any person(s) disrupting the show.
- **Dogs** must be securely tied, caged, in a closed stall, or on a leash at all times while on the show grounds or in the stable area. **No Dogs** allowed in the indoor arena with the exception of service dogs.
- **No smoking** is allowed in the barn areas or in any of the other buildings.

Warm Up Arena Etiquette

As our WE competitions have become larger, the warmup paddock can be a very dangerous place: riders are preoccupied with their horses, and horses can be nervous. To ensure a Safe Warmup Paddock, the Paddock Steward is responsible for monitoring the warmup paddock. Common sense and courtesy can help avoid accidents.

- Only competitors, trainers/coaches, or handlers of horses being prepared are allowed in the paddock. No other pedestrians are allowed.
- Horses going around the perimeter of the arena should ideally be moving in the same direction. Slower horses move to the inside. If horses are traveling in opposite directions, the passing rule is left shoulder to left shoulder.
- No lunging in the warmup paddock while riders are present. Use of a lunge whip should be limited, as cracking the whip can cause dangerous behavior in horses not used to the noise.

- Ponying is not allowed.
- Unruly horses must be removed from the warmup arena.
- No disruptive behavior from horses or humans can be allowed.

Rules and Regulations

Hold Harmless Clause: Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous and dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participant assumes any and all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless, the horse show personnel and the facility hosting the show. **Three Bulls LLC, the Three Bulls Classic Working Equitation Shows**, will not be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses, or property of exhibitors, spectators, or grooms. All local facility rules must be followed.

Media Release Agreement: I agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, or other likenesses of me and/or my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion or benefit of the competition or sport. These likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in any way to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or misappropriation.

1. No smoking is allowed in the Indoor Arena or any of the barns or outbuildings.
2. VEHICLES: Drive Carefully. Watch for children and pets.
3. DOGS/PETS: No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs that are not crated must be on a leash or in a stall. Clean up after dog/pet. No dogs are allowed in the indoor arena except for service dogs.
4. ALCOHOL: All events serving alcohol must comply with ABC laws. If asked to provide identification for purposes of age validation, you must comply. Disorderly patrons will be removed from the premises.
5. THEFT/VANDALISM: Anyone involved in destroying property or found stealing property, will be fully prosecuted.
6. No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
7. No vehicles allowed in the barns.
8. No gray water to be dumped on the ground.
9. No campfires are permitted.
10. Camp sites must be kept clean, and campers must dispose of any trash in receptacles provided. All campers are responsible for leaving their campsite as they found it. Any damage or repairs resulting from negligence shall be the responsibility of the camper.
11. Fireworks are prohibited.

12. Three Bulls reserves the right to remove any camper or visitor who is in violation of these rules and regulations.
13. Three Bulls shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by campers.

Cross over RR tracks then go 1 mile.

Turn **LEFT** onto Beech Grove Road (You will **PASS** the other end of Beech Grove Road on your right shortly before the left turn. **DO NOT TURN RIGHT THERE!**)

RELEASE:

I understand that this is a high-risk sport and I am participating at my own risk. I hereby assume this risk and further do hereby release and hold harmless the organizer (Licensee), organizing committee, competition management, judges and officials; USA Working Equitation (USAWE), its officers, agents, employees and volunteers; the host of this event or competition; and the owners of any property on which the event or competition is being held, from all liability for negligence resulting in accidents, damage, injury, or illness to myself and to my property, including the horse or horses that I will compete at this event or competition.

ENTRY AGREEMENT:

By entering a USAWE-licensed competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Rider, or Parent/Guardian, I agree that I am subject to and agree to be bound by the Bylaws of USAWE applicable to the USAWE-licensed competition, the U.S. Rules for Working Equitation ("Rules"), and the requirements of the competition as stated in the Prize List. I will accept as final the decision of the Protests Committee or Appeals Committee on any question arising under the Rules and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, USAWE, their officials, officers, directors, employee, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, USAWE and/or competition management may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the competition, sport, or USAWE. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

In consideration for my participation in this Competition, **I AGREE to the following:**

- I AGREE that USAWE and the Competition as used herein include the Licensee and competition management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and USAWE affiliates.
- I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider, owner, or parent/guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").
- I AGREE to hold harmless and release USAWE and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of USAWE or the Competition.
- I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of USAWE or the Competition.
- I AGREE to indemnify USAWE and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition I have read the Rules about protective equipment (section 1.9.1.k) and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty. I acknowledge that USAWE strongly encourages me to do so while warning that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely compete in this competition. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation, AGREE to all of the above provisions, and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I understand and AGREE that all competitors under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM/SEI-approved safety helmet.
- I AGREE that if I am injured at this Competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to USAWE and competition management.
